

School selection for pre-school class

The pre-school class is a school form in its own right that can be chosen voluntarily but which the local authority is obliged to provide from the Autumn term of the year in which the child becomes 6.

Following a decision by the Primary and Pre-school Authority, the guardians of all children who have reached the age of 6 will need to make their own choice of school.

Please note that you must register your selection even if you choose the school of your child's primary placement. This is to facilitate the school's planning. The primary placement for your child will appear when you log into the school selection.

If you choose a local authority school in Haninge other than the one of your child's primary placement, the director of the school selected will decide whether a place can be offered. It *may be* that a school is unable to admit all applicants for reasons of space.

Voluntary selection in Haninge Municipality only concerns the choice of school, not the choice of class, group or teacher.

Placement rules

First priority is given to those children whose guardians select the school of the child's primary placement.

If the guardian chooses another local authority school in Haninge, the following order of priority will apply;

1. If the child has a brother or sister who attends the school applied for.
2. According to proximity to the school (but still outside the catchment area). This refers to the actual walking route, not as the crow flies.

Guardians living apart

If one of the guardians lives at an address other than the child's registered address, both guardians must agree on the selection in order for it to be valid. This is done when the notification of admission is sent out to the guardians.

Choosing an independent school (within or outside Haninge)

If you choose an independent school you will need to apply to the school direct, as they have their own waiting lists. The school admitting will decide whether your child can be offered a place.

Register in the school selection system that you have chosen an independent school and state the name of the school.

Choosing a local authority school in another local authority

If you want a place in a local authority school outside Haninge you will need to apply to the school direct. The school admitting will decide whether your child can be offered a place. Register in the school selection system that you have chosen a school in a different local authority and state the name of the school.

Please note that Haninge Municipality is not responsible for admissions to independent schools or schools in other local authorities!

Child care (after-school centres)

If you want a place in an after-school centre, this must also be selected in the school selection module.

Mother tongue

Pupils with guardians who speak a language other than Swedish as their mother tongue and whose mother tongue is the language in everyday use at home are entitled to instruction in the mother tongue. You can select the mother tongue on a special application form, which you can find at haninge.se/forskola-och-skola/modersmal/.

School transport (taxi and SL card)

Pupils at pre-school class are not entitled to school transport. Pupils in years 1-9 who attend a school other than that of the primary placement have limited possibilities for being granted school transport. Pupils who are entitled to school transport at their primary school may be entitled to transport to their chosen school if travel to the school selected does not incur additional expenses for the Municipality compared with what would have applied for the primary placement.

School transport means travel on public transport (SL card) and specially procured school transport services (school bus, school taxi, boat).

The Personal Data Act (PDA)

In compliance with § 10 of the Personal Data Act, the local authority may process personal data if it is necessary for work assignments to be carried out in connection with the exercising of authority.

Personal data processed in the e-service “selection of school” will be registered in compliance with the PDA. The purpose of processing personal data is to administer the selection of schools in Haninge Municipality. Data on mother tongues needs to be processed as in some cases pupils are entitled to mother tongue instruction and the Municipality has a duty to ensure that sufficient resources are made available. The personal data is passed on to the schools concerned.

The officer dealing with personal data is obliged, once a calendar year and free of charge, to advise anyone making such a request whether personal data relating to the applicant has been processed or not (§ 26 of the PDA). The officer dealing with personal data is further obliged, at the request of the person registered, to correct, block or delete immediately any personal data that has not been processed in compliance with this act or regulations issued (§ 28 of the PDA).
